



Alcohol Licence – Keedwell Holdings Limited

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Keedwell Holdings Limited, 42 Main Street, Eketahuna 4900, has made application to the District Licensing Committee at Dannevirke for the renewal of an on licence in respect of the premises situated at 42 Main Street, Eketahuna 4900, known as **EKETAHUNA INN**.

The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is: Hotel, Restaurant/Bar.

The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is intended to be sold under the licence are: Monday to Sunday 8:00am to 2:00am the following day.

The applicant seeks to vary the following condition(s): designation of portions of the premises to undesignated from supervised; add Catering endorsement to the licence.

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours of the Tararua District Licensing Committee at the Dannevirke Service Centre, 26 Gordon Street, Dannevirke.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 25 working days after the first date of publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Tararua District Council, PO Box 115, Dannevirke 4942.

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Objection period closes 27 August 2025.
