12.1 Pahiatua Districts Business Group

A good turnout of approximately 25 people for the inaugural PDBG event. The Business Group now has 19 members and all members have been invoiced member fees. The PDBG bank account is now open.

The next event is to be the Social Media Workshop held on 25th August.

BA5 at Thicket on 15th September. The food allowance for hosting BA5's is to come from PDBG funding.

12.2 Explore Pahiatua Marketing

12.3 Youth Centre

As above, discussions were had around the building lease renewal which expired 30th June 2022.

There has been a further flooding incident at the youth centre on 12th July. Ali Romanos and Gerry Parker have attended the youth centre to undertake some work. The ceiling jib in the kitchen will need to be replaced. Ali Romanos has engaged Joss Tua-Davidson to undertake this work.



12.4 Carnival Park

Annual reporting meeting with Department of Conservation was held on 21st July. Introductions to a new Department of Conservation Communities Manager - Nikki Gasson. Further updates to plans and procedures for working bees in the park going forward. The Annual General Meeting date is set for 17th August.

12.5 Harvard Plane

Gerry Parker has followed up with this and booked the sandblasting and three coats of paint for late August or early September - weather permitting.

12.6 Community Garden

The committee have set monthly meetings for the first Tuesday every month. The community garden sign has been finalised.

12.7 Explore Christmas

The road will be closed only for the parade this year due to costings of the road closure.

Advertising is planned for September, October and November.

Market stalls and food truck interest is growing, and registration forms are now ready to be sent. The cost for registration will be \$20.

Several entertainers, workshops and activities have been secured for Elf Land.

Discussion and outline of current costings are as below.
